Signet clients are now able to complete census information online –and in time online screens will enable shearing ewe weights to be entered too. This short note explains how to complete a census online.



Getting started...

To access the website go to <http://www.basco.org/> and click on “login”

Remember the email address used must be that one currently linked to the flock

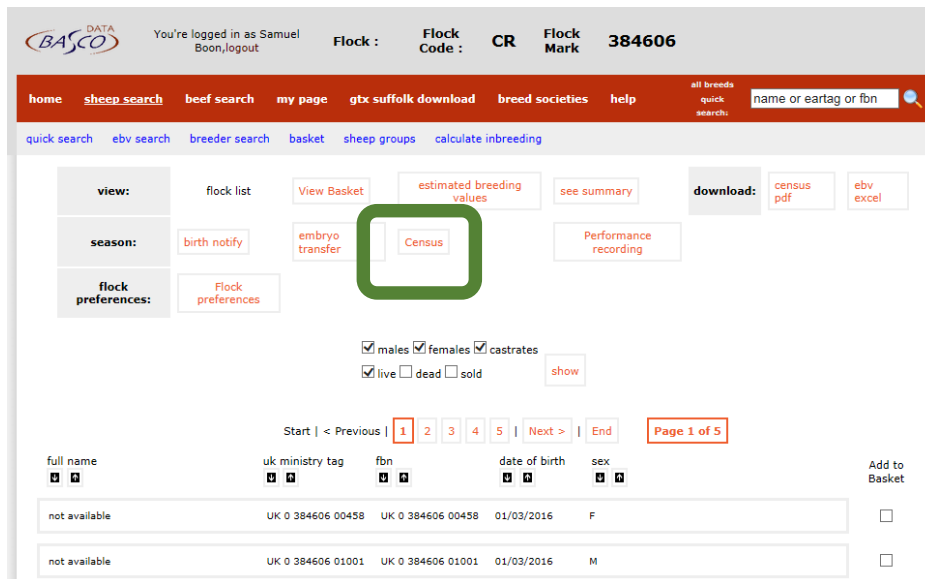
Which email address?

To check this users can go to sheep search / breeder search – and using the drop down menu to select “breed” pull back information about their flock – including their email address.

New users can register via this page. Established users can use the page to re-set their password.

When the user logs on successfully they are taken to “My Page” which will list all of the active flocks in the breeder’s ownership.

Clicking on your flock details provides breeders with access to a number of functions including “birth notify”, “embryo transfer”, “census” and “performance recording” screens. The section you require is “census”



Census

Users can update their flock records using the census screen to let us know those animals that have been sold or died.

The screen is sorted by sex – castrate, female and then male – and then by flockbook number.

Data entered in these fields may be used in genetic evaluations in the future, so please try to record the information accurately. Where a reason is not known – please put “Unknown”.

Remember to press “Submit Screen” once the census has been completed.
